Jordan Lu is a top Canadian golfer originally from the *Nan Yi Golf Country Club* in Taiwan. In 2010, he moved to Vancouver, Canada, to pursue his dream in golf. In 2014, he won the BC Amateur Championship and also claimed the individual title at the BC AAA High School League for two consecutive years. He set a new course record with a score of 63 and was named Athlete of the Year (across all sports). After graduating from high school, he received invitations from around 40 prestigious universities in the U.S. He ultimately chose to join the golf team at the Uni. of Washington with a generous scholarship.

Jordan Lu and his team have designed a one-day golf training camp for adults, during which he will share his experiences studying and playing golf in the U.S. and Canada, along with providing technical instruction on golf skills.
